

In **Cyprus**, the interdisciplinary conference on "Domestic Violence: The Role of Health Professionals in the Victim Support Chain" was successfully completed on October 19, 2024. We gathered over 60 health, physiotherapy and social work professionals, where through interesting discussions, we highlighted the need for:

- Training in the recognition and intervention of incidents of violence.
- Strengthening cooperation between professionals.
- Establishing new protocols for the support of victims.

The conference was organized at the University of Nicosia, with the participation of the Advisory Committee for the Preventing and Combating of Violence in the Family and the Coordinating Body for the Preventing and Combating of Violence against Women of the Ministry of Justice.







On Wednesday, November 27, 2024, a workshop on DV and the role of healthcare and physiotherapy professionals in supporting victims took place in Barcelona - Spain, organized by M&M Profuture Training, S.L. The event, part of the European Program OPEP-DV, provided participants with training on recognizing signs of violence and offering appropriate assistance within their professional scope. The workshop featured practical activities, a panel discussion with experts, and the presentation of the OPEP-DV results, designed to educate physiotherapists on this critical issue. The event, with the participation of experts, students, and teachers of Tecnocampus -Degree of physioterapist, highlighted the importance of professional commitment to addressing gender-based violence and equipping professionals with essential tools.
